1. Competitors may enter ONE singles and ONE doubles. CATEGORIES WITH SMALL ENTRIES MAY BE PUT TOGETHER WITH ANOTHER AGE GROUP AND IF 12's AND 14's . DEPENDING ON THE SIZE OF THE DRAW WE WILL PLAY A KNOCK-OUT DRAW.

2. Competitors must not have attained the age of 10, 12, 14, 16, or 18 as of 1st January, 2017, for entry in the respective age groups. The Committee has the right to request a Competitor to produce his/her birth certificate.

3. Entry forms will be available from, and can be returned to, the Trinidad Country Club (T.C.C), Port of Spain Public Courts, and from the Tennis Association office.

4. Entries close on Saturday 21st October, 2017 and the draw will take place at T.C.C. on Tuesday 24th October at 4.30 pm. The Tournament will take place on FRIDAY 28TH AT 4:00PM, SATURDAY 29TH , SUNDAY 30TH OCTOBER FOR UNDER 10,12,14 AND NOVICE 10 EVENTS , AND FRIDAY 4TH AT 4:00PM, SATURDAY 5TH , SUNDAY 6TH NOVEMBER, 2016 for the UNDER,16 AND 18 EVENTS.

5. PLAYERS MAY HAVE TO PLAY MORE THAN ONE MATCH PER DAY – PLEASE CHECK WITH THE REFEREE BEFORE LEAVING THE VENUE

6. All entries must be made on the official entry forms and accompanied by the entry fee of \$60, together with, where applicable, the Tennis Association of Trinidad and Tobago registration fee of \$65.00, which covers 2017 only.

7. Matches will begin at 9.00 a.m. sharp and players must report to the Referee immediately upon arrival for their match; WITH THE EXCEPTION OF Friday 27th October and Friday 3th November when matches will begin at 4.00 pm

8. For all age groups with five (5) or less entries a Round-robin (RR) format may be played from which a final placement will be determined. In all other instances where RR is played the top two (2) from each group would then proceed to a Knock-out Draw. Depending on the size of the entries, the 12's and 14's may play Knock-out.

In the U10's RR would be played; first to six (6) with a Tie-break (TB) at 5-5, with No-Ad scoring. Knock-Out Draw will played; 2 short sets; 1 set all a 10 point Match Tie-Break. With No Add scoring.

For U12's RR and Knock-out Draw the format will be two (2) short tiebreak sets, at one (1) set all a ten (10) point Match Tie-Break will be played, with No-Ad scoring.

For U14s when a RR is played to determine the Knock-out Draw, the format will be the best of three short tiebreak sets. The Knock-out Draw will be as stated below, with No-Ad scoring.

For the 14's, 16's and 18's, all Main and Knock-out Draws Singles matches will be two tiebreak sets and at set all 10pt match tie-break

(There may be consolation matches for first round losers if time permits).

9. Competitors failing to be present within fifteen minutes after their match is called may be defaulted.

10. Competitors are required to assist in the tournament as lines persons, ball persons or umpires.

11. Every attempt will be made to have the order of play published in the daily newspapers and on the Tennis Patrons website: tennispatronstt.com and www.tennistt.info However, Competitors must make sure to read the notice board at the venue or check with the Referee

For the Order of Play to ascertain the date and time of their match.

12. COMPETITORS ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR PROPER TENNIS ATTIRE. ADVERTISING OF ANY KIND, SLOGANS OR WRITING MORE THAT 2" X 1" ARE NOT ALLOWED. NO T-SHIRTS OTHER THAN THOSE OF THE SPONSOR WILL BE ALLOWED. ALL COMPETITORS RECEIVING PRIZES MUST BE AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY WITH THE TOURNAMENT T-SHIRT. IF NOT COMPETITORS WILL FORGO THEIR PRIZES.

13. At the discretion of the Referee or the Umpire, Competitors may be penalized for violations committed on court, i.e. equipment abuse, verbal abuse, time-wasting, audible obscenities etc. The penalties of these offences are as follows:

First Offence	WARNING
Second Offence	ONE (1) POINT
Third Offence	DEFAULT

14. The Committee reserves the full power, subject to the Rules of Tennis, to alter the above conditions in any way necessary for the benefit of the Tournament.
